
- 1. Member Care.

- 4. Vision Casting. Review Matthew 13.31-32 and coach the <u>multiplication strategy to the right.</u>


Look Up:

Look Ahead:

6. Practice. The Jews in Jesus day searched the scriptures, but missed Jesus (Jn 5.39). To avoid this disciples must read the entire bible, and read it in light of Jesus Christ. The Prophets (OT) and the Apostles (NT) both point to Jesus (Eph 2.19-20). Moses and the Prophets point forward to Jesus (Lk 24.27) and the Apostles point back to him (Acts 4.33). Practice sharing this picture with each other.





- 7. Responding to the Holy Spirit and Prayer. Pray and ask the Holy Spirit how to respond.
 - Follow: Consider the chart at the bottom. Develop a plan for reading the entire bible, while keeping your eyes fixed on Jesus in the gospels. Pray and ask God much scripture should you consume this week to get started?
